Fees: A non-resident fee will be charged to all participants who do not physically reside in Houlton.

Payment: All program fees are due in full at the date of registration.

Refunds:

- If the Department cancels a program, all fees will be refunded.
- If you withdraw before the first day of a program, fees will be refunded as follows:
A credit on your MyRec account minus a \$10 administrative fee.
OR
A check mailed to you minus a \$10 administration fee.
- If you withdraw after a program has begun, there will be no refund.
